Request for application

- Applications are available on-line and can be downloaded from the NCATA Web Site at www.ncathletictrainer.org
- Criteria for Nomination:
 - Rising College Freshman
 - Expresses an interest in continuing athletic training at the college level
 - Must have attained “hands on” experience as a student assistant in athletic training (Completing a Sports Medicine class does not count as “hands on” experience).
 - Attendance at sport medicine camps and clinics
 - Community service
 - Academic achievement
 - Good moral character

Selection

- Application, high school transcript, and recommendations from:
 - Administrator or Teacher
 - Athletic Director
 - Licensed Athletic Trainer (NCATA Member)
- Must be returned to the NCATA Secretary in ONE mailing and received by April 15.
- Selection will be done by the Awards Committee
- Winner will be announced at the NCATA Sports Medicine Symposium for Students and will be presented with an award

The Treasurer shall be responsible for securing awards to be presented at the Sports Medicine Symposium for Students in July.

College Scholarships (3 @ \$1,500)

The NCATA offers three scholarships for current athletic training students enrolled at a college or university in North Carolina.

- Applications – Applications are available on-line and can be downloaded from the NCATA Web Site at www.ncathletictrainer.org
- Must be postmarked by February 1.

Eligibility:

1. Be a current member of the NCATA, applicant must provide a copy of current NATA membership card
2. Be currently enrolled in a CAATE accredited athletic training education program (ATEP) in North Carolina
3. Must have earned a minimum of 2.5 overall GPA, and a 3.0 in ATEP courses
4. Three letters of recommendation from the following sources:
 - ATEP Director
 - LAT, ATC clinical supervisor (must be different from program director)
 - one additional letter from: AD, MD, coach, instructor or Athletic Trainer
5. An official sealed transcript
6. An unofficial transcript with ATEP classes highlighted
7. An essay that must be typed, 10 point minimum, addressing future plans and goals for achievement

Selection:

- A selection committee comprised by no less than five non-college/university members will be assembled. The members will evaluate each candidate’s application and rank their choices. Consideration should be given to students actively engaged in athletic training, attendance at athletic training camps/clinics/conferences, community service, scholarship and good moral character. The three applicants with the highest rankings will be selected as award winners.

Award winners will be recognized at the annual business meeting in March. Plaques will be presented to the individual as well as their respective school. A check for the award will be presented to the award winner.
